The minister stands and addresses the congregation







The Words of Our Lord


MATT 26:26-28; MARK 14:22-24, LUKE 22:19-20


The Holy Eucharist at Zion

This is considered an intimate fellowship with our Lord as we 'discern" Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, in giving us His body and blood, for the forgiveness of our sins. We invite you to participate in receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion if: You are a Christian, have been baptized and instructed in the teachings of the Christian Faith, and believe that the true Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus is present in the bread and wine you receive at this Altar. If you do not believe or understand this, please meet with Pastor Francis following church services, and come to the Altar during Communion, crossing your arms over your chest to receive Christ's blessing.
